SMM Food Pantry

The Food Pantry ministry is an important ministry at St. Mary Magdalene providing help to those in need in our area. The SMM Food Pantry operates every Wednesday morning and is one of the few pantries in the area that provides a meal in addition to providing food supplies. Each week, about twenty parishioners are involved in interviewing and registering qualified clients, preparing meals in the kitchen, and retrieving, organizing, packaging and distributing food supplies to our clients. The SMM Food Pantry purchases our food supplies from the East Texas Food Bank and typically serves 40-80 clients per week at a cost of \$500-1000. The Food Pantry also coordinates with the ALMS committee to provide additional assistance to clients in the form of gas cards and store gift cards, as funds allow.

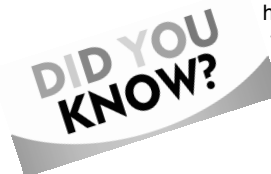

SAINTS FOR THE WEEK

Saturday, February 17, The Seven Holy Founders of the Servite Order – The Order of Friar Servants of Mary or Servites (O.S.M.), founded by seven Florentine cloth merchants in 1223, today numbering about 855 religious; they popularized devotion to Our Lady of Sorrows.

Wednesday, February 21, Saint Peter Damian, Bishop, Doctor of the Church – died in 1072; indefatigable defender of the Gregorian reform; O.S.B. monk, later Cardinal bishop of Ostia; promoter of religious life.

Thursday, February 22, THE CHAIR OF SAINT PETER THE APOSTLE – Today's feast attested as early as the mid-fourth century has its roots in the commemoration of dead relatives and friends (Parentalia), celebrated in Rome between 13-22 Feb. At this commemoration, a chair (cathedra) was left empty for particular deceased persons. Since the actual date of St. Peter's death was unknown, it came to be commemorated on 22 Feb., eventually celebrating his taking pastoral responsibility of the Church of Rome.

Friday, February 23, Saint Polycarp, Bishop, Martyr – died in 155 at age eighty-six; disciple of St. John and bishop of Smyrna; his "Letter to the Philippians" witnesses to various New Testament writings; the "Martyrdom of Polycarp" records his being burned at the stake; one of the first martyrs to be venerated.
