Monday, March 7, Saints Perpetua and Felicity; Martyrs -- Perpetua, a noble lady, and Felicity, her slave, died at Carthage in 203 under Septimus Severus; names mentioned in the Roman Canon.

<u>Tuesday, March 8, Saint John of God, Religious</u> -- died in 1550 in granada; shepherd, soldier, and entrepreneur before his conversion at age forty-two; laid foundation (1537) for the Order of Hospitallers (O.H.), today numbering about, 1,100 religious; patron of hospitals and the sick, of nurses and booksellers.

<u>Wednesday, March 9, Saint Frances of Rome, Religious</u> -- died in 1440; noblewoman, wife, and mother; founded a community of Benedictine women oblates committed to serving the poorest of the poor; patroness of widows and motorists.
