
What should I give up for Lent?

Abstaining from meat on Fridays during Lent is a sacrifice and a small act of self-discipline that dates back to the early Church.

What is the colour of Lent?

Purple is the colour of Lent. On Laetare Sunday priests will wear pink as a small break from the solemn purple and a reminder that Easter is drawing near. During Palm Sunday and Good Friday, priests will wear red vestments. The colour of Easter is white.




