

OPEN DOORS

"Do you think Mary will do the upcoming Cursillo retreat?" That was the question someone asked me recently. And honestly I was pretty convinced she wouldn't. She has been away from the church for a long time and it seemed like this would be way outside her comfort zone. But I have made it a practice to never say "no" for someone else, so I simply told my friend that I didn't think Mary would be interested, but she should definitely ask!

I'm sure you can guess where this is going... my friend asked and Mary said yes, and I am glad I didn't put a roadblock to the request.

Let me share a similar story, but this one happened at least 15 years ago. I was tasked with finding a new couple to participate in our COR retreats in the parish. This was a commitment to do two retreats a year for almost 2 ½ years, so it was a big ask. I would often look around me at mass and pray to the Holy Spirit about who I should ask. I could anticipate that I would have to ask 5-10 couples before someone said yes so you can imagine how daunting this task was.

This particular time I had asked a few people and in my prayers I was directed toward a couple I will call Sam and Martha. Now, I don't remember the details, but Sam does, and he has shared many times that I 'chased them

down the road' to ask if they would consider being leaders on COR. When I asked he informed me that he wasn't actually Catholic, but I told him we could get past that. And, wonder of wonders, they said yes!

The simple act of extending an invitation can open doors to unexpected transformations, and the fact that Sam wasn't even Catholic at the time underscores the idea that God works in ways that are beyond our understanding, using unexpected individuals to play vital roles in ministry.

Sam and Martha's initial hesitation and subsequent

acceptance of the invitation showcase the impact that a welltimed request can have on someone's faith journey. Sam's acknowledgment of how that invitation affected his spiritual path speaks volumes about the ripple effect of participation in ministry – not just for the individuals involved but for the entire faith community. It's a reminder that God often calls us to approach people we might not initially consider, and through invitations. incredible blessings and contributions can emerge.

I pray that you will continue to be open to the leading of the Holy Spirit, unafraid to extend invitations, and trusting that God can work wonders through the seemingly ordinary act of asking someone to participate in ministry. Who knows what remarkable transformations and blessings may unfold as a result of our willingness to invite others into deeper engagement with their faith.
