SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

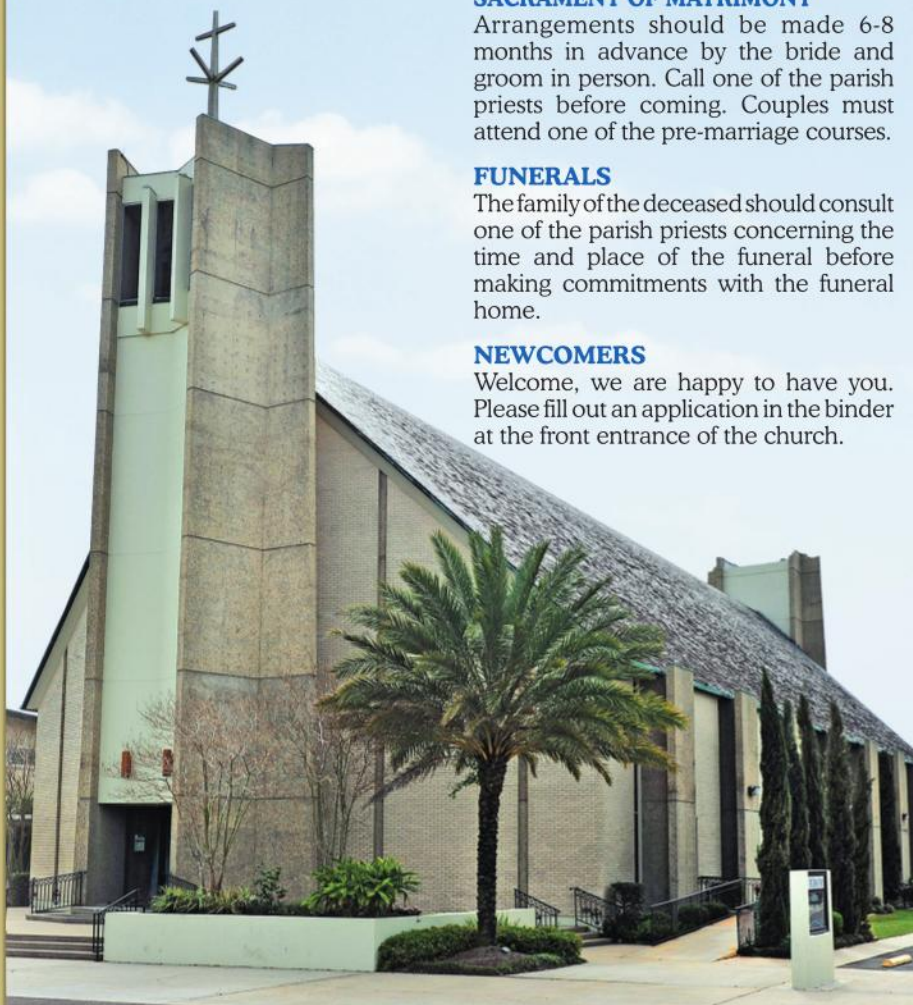
Arrangements should be made 6-8 months in advance by the bride and groom in person. Call one of the parish priests before coming. Couples must attend one of the pre-marriage courses.

Welcome, we are happy to have you. Please fill out an application in the binder at the front entrance of the church.



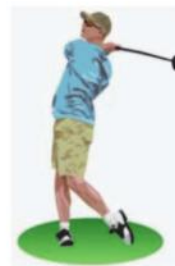

LENT GUIDELINES

THE LENTEN SEASON

A distinction is to be made between Lent and the Easter Triduum. Strictly speaking, Lent ends with the beginning of the Triduum on Holy Thursday. The Ordo notes: "Lent runs from Ash Wednesday until the Mass of the Lord's Supper exclusive on Holy Thursday."

FASTING AND ABSTINENCE Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to each one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years or older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and on all Fridays of Lent. The determination of certain days as obligatory days of penance should not be understood as limiting the occasions for Christian penance.

MAINTAINING THE SPIRIT OF THE SEASON OF LENT

The Spirit of the season of Lent should be maintained throughout the weeks of Lent. The obligation to observe penitential days of the Church is a very important part of our spiritual life. Individual circumstances must be taken into account, but in general, people should seek to do more rather than less, since fast and abstinence on the days prescribed should be considered a minimal response to the Lord's call to penance and conversion of life.

Second Collection

The second collection this week will be for building and maintenance.

Annulment Writing Workshop

The Archdiocese of New Orleans will offer a writing workshop for persons seeking an annulment in the Catholic Church or for persons responding to an annulment. The workshop will be held in St. Clement of Rome's Parish Center in Metairie. The series will be for three (3) Saturdays, March 24, April 7, and April 14, 2018. Hours are 8:30 AM- noon. The materials for the series cost \$25.00.

Fr. Michael O'Connor is a native of Ocean Springs, MS and the youngest of five children. He graduated from Ocean Springs High School in 1983, and in 1987 he graduated from the University of Southern Mississippi in Hattiesburg where he received his bachelor's degree in psychology. Upon graduation he was commissioned into the United States Air Force as a Second Lieutenant. He served as a military officer both on active duty and in the Mississippi Air National Guard, principally in Radar Operations, Surveillance and Air Weapons Control. Fr. O'Connor attained the rank of Major and worked full-time for the Mississippi Air Guard from 1990 until he answered the call to enter the seminary in 2000.

He attended Notre Dame Seminary in New Orleans and was ordained a priest of the Lord Jesus Christ on June 11, 2005. His first assignment was to The Cathedral of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Biloxi. In 2007 he was assigned to be pastor of Sacred Heart Catholic Church in the Dedeaux Community which is about 20 miles north of Pass Christian. In 2014 he was appointed pastor of Our Lady of the Gulf parish in Bay St. Louis.

In addition to parish ministry he has done a number of parish missions and religious pilgrimages. He also serves as the spiritual director for the Cursillo movement of South Mississippi, is a member of the Deacon Formation Board, and he is on the bishop's Presbyteral Council. He has run two marathons and enjoys fishing.

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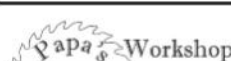
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
