SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

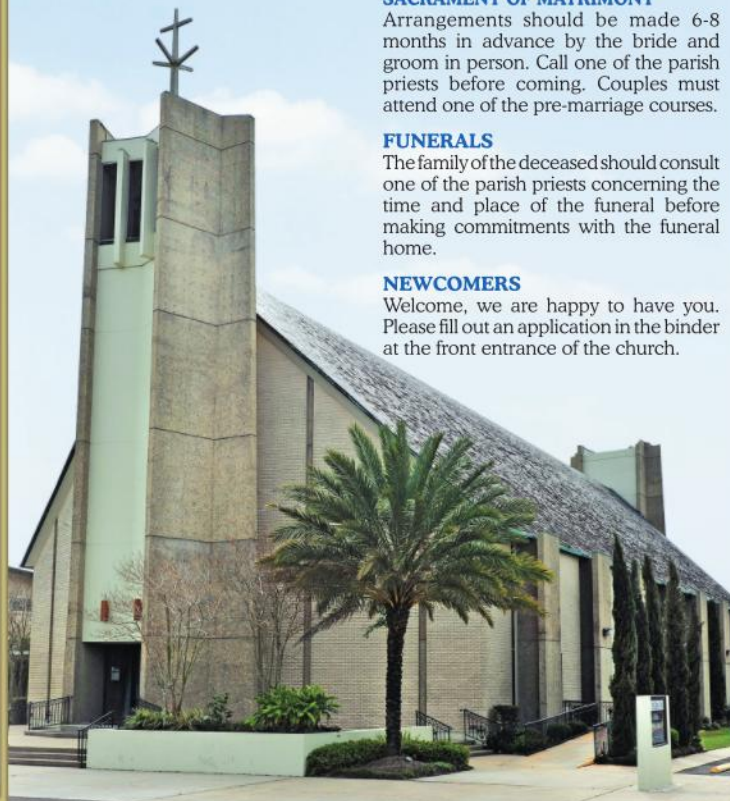
Arrangements should be made 6-8 months in advance by the bride and groom in person. Call one of the parish priests before coming. Couples must attend one of the pre-marriage courses.

Bricks for the Unborn

This is a work in progress by the Knights of Columbus until we fill inscriptions on all the bricks.

Cross Catholic Outreach

Fr. Thomas A. Wantland of Catholic Outreach will be visiting our parish on June 23-24 2018. To speak at all the Masses on Behalf of the poor in developing countries.

Cross Catholic Outreach was founded to create a meaningful link between parishes in America and the priests and nuns working in the Church overseas in the Caribbean, Africa, Central and South America.

WHAT IS RCIA?

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process established for the universal Church for individuals to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation-Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. This initiation process also involves a parish community experiencing a renewal in faith as it prepares and welcomes new members into the Church. The Rite speaks of conversation as a "spiritual journey". Centered on fostering a deep relationship with Jesus and the Church he founded, this journey takes place through distinct stages over a period of time suitable to bring thorough catechesis, significant experience of a parish community and commitment to liturgical and moral life of the Catholic faithful. The RCIA process is a restoration of the ancient catechumenate, arising within the first three centuries. The Second Vatican Council called for the restoration and use of this venerable and powerful method of initiation for the worldwide Church.

Whom is RCIA for?

1. Persons in need of Baptism.
2. Persons baptized in another Christian tradition who desire to become Catholic.
3. Persons baptized Catholic in need of First Communion and/or Confirmation.

I want to first thank Father Steve for this opportunity to write a little blurb about what I am currently doing. My name is Peter Nguyen, and I am a New Orleans native, graduate of Tulane University '17. I am now serving as a FOCUS missionary at Harvard University.

FOCUS, which stands for Fellowship of Catholic University Students, is a Catholic organization founded in 1998 in order to meet the needs of Catholic college students on campus. Mother Teresa said: "The poverty in the West is a different kind of poverty -- it is not only a poverty of loneliness but also of spirituality. There's a hunger for love, as there is a hunger for God." Curtis Martin, our founder, noticed a deep spiritual poverty in college students. Our students face a crisis of identity and belief; I have seen it for myself while at Tulane and Harvard. Our missionaries are recent college graduates who are formed in prayer and the sacraments. We go on campus to help students come to know Jesus Christ and His Church and to share the Gospel with others. We facilitate this through small group bible studies and intentional mentoring relationships. We have missionaries serving at around 138 campuses in America and Europe.

As a FOCUS missionary, I have the opportunity to fundraise my salary, by inviting people to commit to being on my monthly support team, contributing financially to my mission. All of my donors pray for me intentionally, and I also pray for them. Without them, I simply could not be on mission; they, through me, affect the students. As Mother Teresa again states, "Some people give by going and some go by giving".
