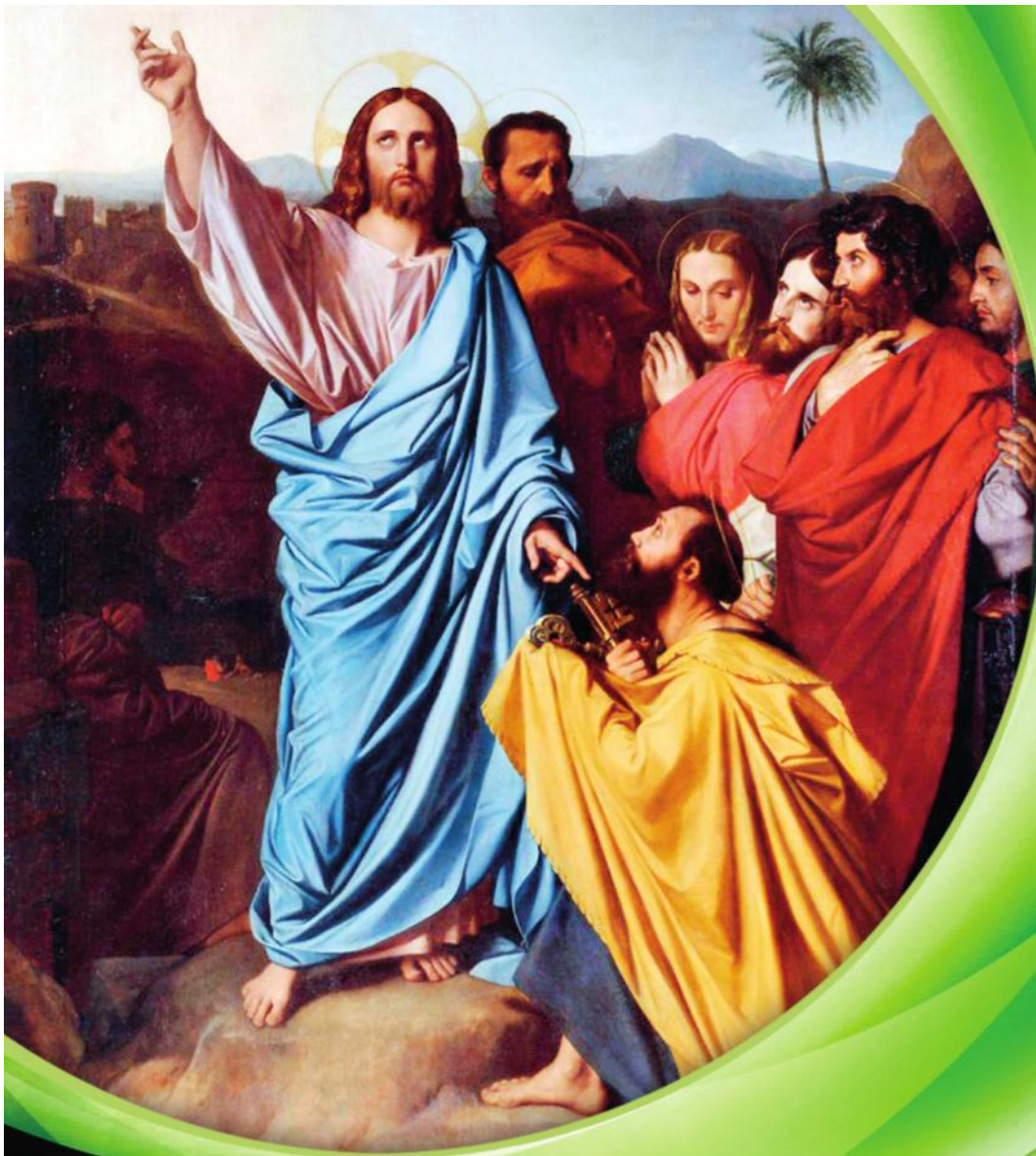

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

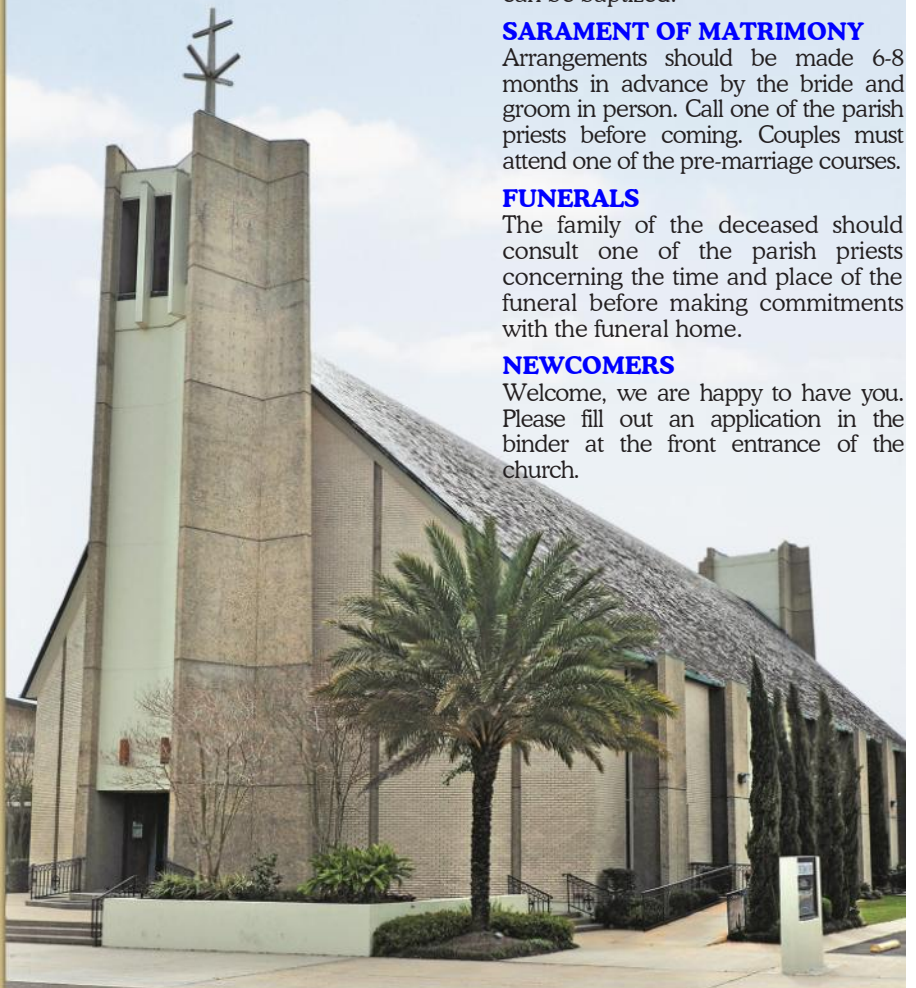
Arrangements should be made 6-8 months in advance by the bride and groom in person. Call one of the parish priests before coming. Couples must attend one of the pre-marriage courses.

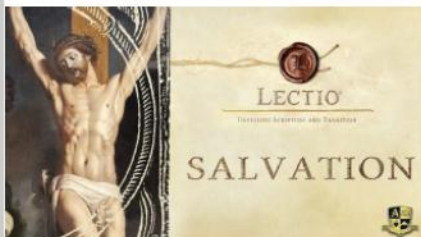

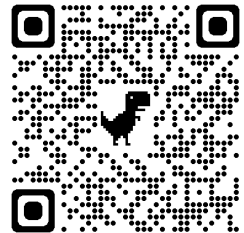

The bishops of the United States have been promoting a National Eucharistic Revival since last summer. We have all heard the statistics about how few Catholics actually believe what the Church teaches about the Eucharist, usually because they were never actually clearly taught by their teachers that the Blessed Sacrament is not a mere symbol but is actually the Real Presence of Jesus: Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity! The church calls the Eucharist "the source and summit of the Christian life." Our life as Christians is meant to revolve around the Eucharist! Now, to be fair, the Archdiocese of New Orleans had a "Year of the Eucharist" not very long ago, in an attempt to respond to how the pandemic disrupted so many people's commitment to attending Mass. So that might be why you haven't heard much about the National Eucharistic Revival. Well, now you have! And to help us all focus on the great gift that we have in the Eucharist, Fr. Steve and I would like to highlight for you a few videos on Formed.org, which is available to you for free by going to formed.org/signup and creating a free account (which barely takes 2 minutes to do). THEN, once you have the account, you can search for Presence or go to watch.formed.org/presence, OR scan this handy QR code with your phone's camera and watch the videos on your phone (after you sign in)! This week, let's all watch Episode 1 in our homes as a parish, and let our devotion to Jesus in the Eucharist be renewed!

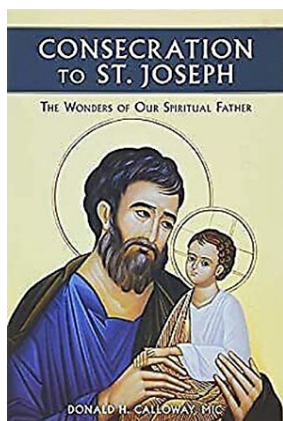

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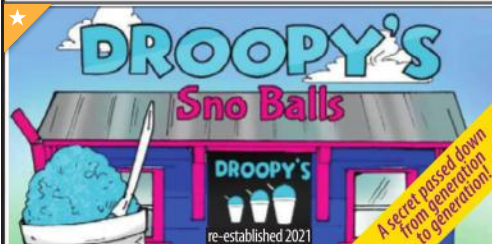


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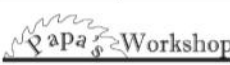
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
