Latin prayers weekly checklist

Oremus/Let us pray

St. William of York Catholic Church and school regularly pray our common prayers in Latin. Latin is the language that expresses our unity with the Catholic Church throughout all time; we glorify God in prayer in the same manner as the Church Triumphant - the saints - have throughout Christian history. Below is a checklist of our common prayers. We encourage all students to pray these prayers daily in Latin, however students should practice their prayers in Latin at least **4 days per week**.

Your students' matching activity page is attached at the end of the checklist to help your student learn the prayers he or she will hear and pray in school. There are links to the prayer so that your student can hear the prayers spoken in Ecclesiastical Latin - the pronunciation of the Church.

Attached are learning tools for the students designed to help the student connect the Latin words with their English understanding. *I recommend slipping the worksheets into a sheet protector and using a dry erase marker to fill in blanks. You may copy and color or fill in as many times as you like. The more the better!
