

Pastor Notes

May 29, 2016



Today the Church celebrates The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Traditionally known as Corpus Christi, this was a feast that included processions and adorations in

parishes. Particularly in Italy, entire villages would close their streets to allow the procession of the Blessed Sacrament to pass by homes and businesses. While we don't have a procession this year, let us do our best to be renewed in our Lord's Ultimate Sacrifice and renew our Love for our Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament. As a reminder, we have Eucharistic Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament every week. Join us in Trinity Chapel between 10 am Thursdays and 3 pm Fridays. We can always use adorers during the early hours on Friday morning. Interested? Call the parish office for information.

Our summer Mass schedule is in place. Please note that our Sunday 5:00 pm Mass is suspended until Sunday, September 11; however there will Mass on Sunday, August 7 at 5:00 pm. This is in conjunction with our intense week of Religious Education (August 7-12) and our parish picnic on August 7. Bishop Bradley will be here to celebrate the 50th anniversary of our parish that weekend, too. It's going to be a BUSY day.

Monday, May 30, is Memorial Day. In 1866, following the Civil War, there was a national effort to commemorate those who died during the War Between the States. I remember going to school on Decoration Day for morning classes. Then, we would have a parade to the local cemeteries for tributes and honors. Today, it's another day off. However, I hope that you take time to share in some community events. There is mass at 9:15am as usual. At 10:00 am, there is the annual Memorial Day Parade in Portage. I will march with our preschool kids and families. (Last year, you would think that I was running for office!) Our parish even has a float this year in honor of our Golden Jubilee. If Monday is just a day off and for relaxing, don't forget those who made the Ultimate Sacrifice, so that we can enjoy our freedoms.

The replica of the Shroud of Turin remains on display this week in Trinity Chapel. If you haven't seen it, don't miss the opportunity. While the Church has made no claim to its authenticity, it remains a cherished relic.

I hope that spring has arrived and plans to stay around. With the month of June upon us, soon it will be summertime. Whatever it may do outside, I hope that you and I can be warmth and sunshine to others. Blessings on these final days of May.
