Pastor Notes

June 12, 2016



Dear People of the Parish,

We welcome Fr. Bob Flickinger to our 9:00am and 11:00am Masses this weekend. He is speaking on behalf of our sister parish in El Sitio, El Salvador. Please welcome our former pastor in the appeal for volunteers and possible participants in a journey to our sister parish. I will

be offering the Sunday Masses for Fr. Bob's parish in South Haven.

Next Sunday is Fathers' Day. After each of the weekend Masses, we will recognize and pray for our dads. It's only been a national holiday since 1972, though its origins date back to 1910 when the State of Washington declared this observance. Over the years, Fathers' Day had its opponents, but its popularity gained momentum. It may never reach the popularity of Mothers' Day, but it provides an opportunity to express our thanks to our dads. So, Mothers' Day is in May and Fathers' Day is in June. I remember asking my dad when it was Children's Day. He responded, "Every day is children's day."

The last few weeks have been busy for most of our priests. While we will have a complete change of priests at the parish, most parishes in the Diocese are saying goodbye to their pastors and preparing to welcome their new pastors. Presently, I am packing up my possessions. It's hard to believe what I have collected over the years. To be honest, I have accumulated too much. In an attempt to make my move lighter, there will be a garage sale. The sale will be in the Guadalupe Worship Room in the Stanley Centre,. The sale will be Friday, June 17 from 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm and Saturday, June 18 from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm. It will be an assortment of dishes, glassware, memorabilia, Christmas ornaments and decorations, and other souvenirs as well. It's time to downsize my collections.

I have sent out one more request for the Bishop's Annual Appeal. At this writing, we have only heard from 500 families. I will always be grateful for those who have responded. Now, we need to hear from the rest of our parish family. Without the BAA, we would not have any priests to serve in our parishes. With BAA, our future priests are trained, our deacons prepared for service, and our many layers of lay ministry fortified by the Lord's teachings. It is my hope that our parish will reach its goal by June 30. It's possible, but only if we hear from you. May God bless you.

You will have a chance to say goodbye to Fr. Ben, Fr. Dan and me. This weekend, Fr. Ben will say good bye at all the Masses, with a farewell reception after 5:30 pm Mass on Saturday. (He had planned a vacation from June 12-26 before the announcements.) On Friday, June 24, following our Gathering Band's evening of praise, there will be a farewell reception to wish me well. On Saturday, June 25, following the 5:30 pm Mass, there will be a farewell reception to honor Fr. Dan. On Sunday, June 26, Fr. Dan and I will say goodbye after all the weekend masses.

These last days of June will be a busy time as we move out and prepare the rectory for Fr. Ken, Fr. Stan and Fr. Bruno. Fr. Dan will offer mass on Tuesday, June 28 at 9:15am. (It will be his 52nd birthday.) Fr. Ben will offer mass on Wednesday, June 29 at 9:15am (his third anniversary of his ordination). I will offer Mass on Thursday, June 30 at 9:15am in the Trinity Chapel.

Eucharistic Adoration will be suspended June 30-July 1, in anticipation of the Fourth of July holiday. We will resume Eucharistic adoration on July 7-8.

Hearing Aid Assistance

We now have additional hearing assistance for those who wear hearing aids. If your hearing aid has a Telecoil (or "T-coil," or a "T" setting), you may borrow a personal hearing aid loop for use during Mass. The loop, worn around the neck, eliminates ambient noise in the church, such as echo, crying children, etc., and directs the sound signal of music and speech directly into your hearing aid. The result is greatly improved sound clarity.

You may borrow a hearing aid loop from the AV person at the sound desk in the back of the church. We also have hearing assist devices for those without T-coil equipped hearing aids, as well as large print and Braille Mass cards.



Hello Saint Catherine's! My name is Clark Thompson, and I am a seminarian for the diocese here in Kalamazoo. As much as I love my books and my academics back at school, nothing beats actually being in a parish with the people I feel so drawn and called to. I very much look forward to meeting as many of you as I can, and I ask that we truly keep each other in our prayers.
