Ken's Kaleidoscope





As I write this, it's a couple of days before my outpatient surgery. By the time you read this I am hoping that everything went well and that I am now on the other side and well-recovered. I'm not used to the long lead-time to prepare my column for the bulletin.

I do want to say this, and feel free to spread the word: the Kaleidoscope is the means for me to communicate with the entire parish. When I am at Sunday masses, I only see some people on any particular weekend. So when I have announcements to make, changes are made and explained, new initiatives are announced, etc., they will appear here in the Kaleidoscope. If you want to know what's going on, if you like to be "in the know," then picking up a bulletin (or reading it online) is the best thing you can do.

More and more people are discovering that they have no tolerance for gluten, and that makes receiving Holy Communion difficult to impossible for them. However, we have low-gluten hosts available which permits many people to receive Holy Communion who otherwise cannot. It's a simple process of coming into the sacristy before mass and letting the sacristan know that you would like such a host, and then approaching the priest-presider to receive communion (because he will have the pyx with those hosts).
