Ken's Kaleidoscope

March 11, 2018



This is a "teaching week" for me as I lead a parish mission for three parishes in New Buffalo, Three Oaks, and Sawyer on three evenings this week -- something I also did for St. Catherine's in the past before I was pastor here. Then I will be teaching a class for WMU on trauma recovery at their Grand Rapids campus on the weekend.

Father Ken's Booklist #5

Jesus: A Portrait, Gerald O'Collins

Two thousand years later, how do we get to *know Jesus personally?* He left no writings for us. His "public" life may have lasted from only a year to three years. Those who wrote the Gospels about him a generation or more after his death and resurrection came from a perspective of faith with an "agenda" to provide a spiritual message; they had no intention to write what we might consider to be an "objective history" about the man. (It is likely that three of the evangelists had never met him.) And even if they had, is history what we need in order to know someone personally? Does an obituary really tell us very much about a person?

There are often considered to be three stages in this testimony about Jesus: what people heard and told one another during his lifetime, and sometimes interpreting that message; handing on a tradition (some oral, some writing) about what Jesus had said and done, including who he was/is, and what it meant; writing it down in the form we now call the four Gospels. Each stage of transmission and each version of the Gospel gives us another perspective, because of what was remembered (and what was not included), how it was interpreted at the time, and how it was ordered and set down for those who followed. So we actually have many different portraits we can examine.

Fr. O'Collins uses a lifetime of study and personal prayer to write this book. He brings us fresh perspectives to what may be very familiar words. He believes that whether we are hearing the Gospels while assembled for worship or reading it for private prayer, we are invited to see Jesus using the gift of our imagination. We begin to encounter not only the Jesus, a man situated in human history, but also the Lord of the Universe. In doing so, we not only learn about him, but we learn about ourselves, our community and our world. God bless your reading and prayer!


