Many thanks to the many volunteers who worked on our parish picnic, including a large cadre of the Knights of Columbus, kitchen helpers, young people running games for younger people, those making snow cones and cotton candy, staff making special beverages, as well as Mary and Gary Hunt who got the whole thing organized, and started roasting the pig at midnight. You might have noticed that the weather

was warm, so most of the picnickers stayed inside and we still had a good time. I kept thinking to myself about VBS' Splash Canyon and the final day's adventures -- it didn't cool me down, but it revived my happy memories.

Some statistics about our parish in the year from July 2017 to June 2018: We welcomed 69 infants and one adult into the Catholic Church through baptism, and 5 baptized who were already baptized entered into full communion with the Catholic Church. 71 children received Holy Communion for the first time, and 50 young people received the sacrament of Confirmation. There were 15 weddings and 53 deaths. We have welcomed 273 people to our parish who constitute 114 households.

To Share the Gospel is the primary purpose of the church. How are we doing?



What follows is a testimony from Allen Buhl, a parishioner, about his experience of JustFaith. "I was surprised that the Justfaith class changed me. It pushed me outside my comfort zone. I met folks, heard their stories and that moved me. It inspired me to work with the disadvantaged through St. Vincent de Paul and AARP TaxAid. I find myself discussing poverty and justice issues with my family, friends, and acquaintances, also a surprise."

Marriage Ministry—Are you the same person that you were when you first got married? In this great vocation, have you been invited to say "I do" again and again through great joys and sometimes painful challenges that have made you into renewed followers of Jesus Christ where you two become one? Do you have an interest in sharing the fruits and experience of marriage with engaged couples who are preparing for marriage?
