

Dear Parishioners,

There's nothing like the feeling of a job well done. We stand back, look at our accomplishments, and realize that what we did was good work. This Labor Day weekend is an opportunity for every one of us to look at the work that we do. But

even more importantly: the work that was done for our Lord.

Sometimes we may wonder how the things of everyday life can be done for the Lord. Yet, being a good husband or wife, a good father or mother (or grandfather or grandmother), all these things can be a way that lead us closer to the Lord. In the "busyness" of life, it's sometimes hard to see this. Despite this, God can bless us in our daily work even when we are not expecting to find God working in this way.
