Dear Parishioners,

Hey Father, isn't there a Holy Day coming up in August?

That's a normal question I expect to hear around the middle of August. Of course, this is one of those calendar years that the answer is both "Yes" and "No."

The **Feast of the Assumption**, celebrated on August 15 is always considered to be a Holy Day. However, due to the way that the calendar lines up this year, August 15 falls on a Saturday. Therefore, it is not a Holy Day of Obligation (due to the weekend), but for those who would still like to celebrate, a Daily Mass will be offered at **9:15 am** on **August 15 in Marian Hall**.

Later that afternoon we will begin our Sunday Masses with the 4 pm Vigil for the 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time. Whenever the calendar does this to us, it always causes a little confusion as to what the expectation is for attending Mass.

We will be putting the finishing touches on the decisions for Fall programs. Please stay tuned for the upcoming announcements.

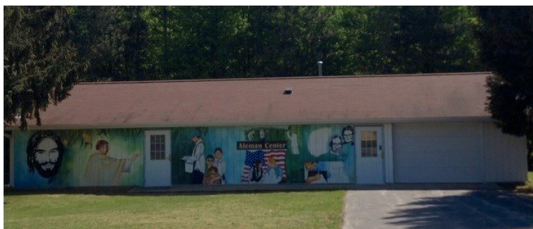
Family and Children Services – Programs include foster care and adoption, counseling, crisis intervention, and family preservation. They have a secure website at <https://www.fcsource.org> with easy online monetary donations through Network for Good and are always in need of ‘in-kind’ gifts such as diaper or personal care products for their ‘pantry.’ They also collect books and board games for the Family Center Resource Room.
