

HOPE! As we begin this second week of Advent in this unusual year of 2020, we need to see the hope that Christ can bring to us. So much has happened during this calendar year. Even though I have been asking for

weeks now (in a joking way) if we have made it to 2021, this doesn't mean that we should lose hope. Take a look at the history of the people of Israel and the many things that they endured. They waited for many centuries for their Savior. Then it finally happened: Jesus Christ was born! The world was changed forever because hope never died. Letter from Fr. Mark

Dear Parishioners:

We are happy to announce our plans for the 2020 Christmas Masses. We appreciate everyone who completed our survey to help us determine the best times for everyone. Christmas Masses will look a bit different this year. For those planning to attend in person, we are working with reduced seating capacity of 25%, social distancing, and the need to wear a face mask.

Christmas Eve Masses (in the main church, overflow in Marian Hall): 4 pm, 7 pm, and 10 pm Christmas Day Mass (in the main church, overflow in Marian Hall): 10 am

Additional Masses in the STANLEY CENTRE GYM will be available should we exceed the capacities in the Church and Marian Hall during any of these times.

What should you expect for Christmas Masses in 2020 at St. Catherine?

- If you are not feeling well, please stay home and watch the live stream Mass on our website, on our Facebook, or on our YouTube channel.
- Although Bishop Bradley has granted dispensation from attending Masses, <u>please remember your</u>
 <u>obligation to be mindful of your relationship with God and our need to give God thanks, especially on</u>
 <u>the day we celebrate the birth of Jesus</u>. Those who are sick or in a high-risk category (due to health
 problems) are encouraged to watch the live stream Mass.
- 3. No reservations or holding seats before Masses. Seating will be first come, first serve at all our Mass times for Christmas. We ask that you do not hold spots or pews for family members. We will not have additional seating in the Narthex area. We will not "pack" the church as we have in previous years. Our ushers will direct you to your seats.
- Please arrive early. Once capacity is reached, doors will be closed, and you will be directed to go to the gym or come to another Mass.
- We will livestream the Vigil Mass of Christmas at 4 pm on Christmas Eve on our website, on our Facebook page, and on our YouTube channel. The video of this Mass will then be available for viewing in all three locations.
- All our areas used for Mass will be cleaned and disinfected between Mass times. This includes the bathrooms and other common areas.

I ask for your continued patience during these difficult times. If you and your family can join us for Christmas Mass, we will be ready to welcome you for our Christmas celebration.

Please note: Due to the Pandemic, any changes to the regulations and restrictions by the State or the Diocese could change our Christmas plans as outlined above. Please read the bulletin, our Facebook page, and our website for the most up to date information.

Youth Faith Formation Confirmation Preparation Plan for Grades 6-12

We will be offering two program options. On-Line and In-Person

6th graders can only do the online option for now.

7th graders can do online with some possible limited in-person.

8th-12th graders can do both programs, at the same time.

Online Diocesan Program: http://www.diokzoo.org/theway

- Go to the website above, find the grade that is appropriate.
- Do this program at your own pace.
- \Rightarrow 9th-12th grade Confirmation Candidates use the 8th grade module.
- \Rightarrow 7th-12th graders doing this program for Confirmation Credit must do the following:
 - At the end of each session are questions. Write an answer to 4
 of the questions listed.
 - Turn those into Philip Dezern and you will get 1 hour of credit towards Confirmation, per session of questions you complete.
 You can email or mail these to Philip Dezern.
 - You can turn these in after each session, monthly, or after all sessions are completed. Please put your name top of the sheet and the grade you are in, as well as session topic.

Limited In-Person Program: Check the bulletin for dates

- We are not guaranteeing we will be offering in-person activities every month.
- You will register with Philip Dezern by email or phone call per session.
- Registration is cut off Saturday at noon or when activity is full. We cannot take walk-ins.
- Each session will count 1.5 hours towards Confirmation.
- Masks are required for all in-person activities.
- Please bring your own water bottles as the drinking fountains will be non-functional.

- We are limited in the number we can take due to social distancing guidelines and leaders.

What Do You Need for Confirmation?

You must complete 60 hours of youth ministry activities (starting in 7th grade). This can be done over a two to four year span. The Confirmation Record Keeping Form needs to be turned in the year you wish to be confirmed. You need to do service hours (the number of hours is up to you and your parents). The year you get confirmed, you need to write a letter to the Bishop, a paper on your service work, and a paper on a saint. Candidates choose a sponsor (not the parents) who is at least 16 and a practicing Catholic. Remember, being a sponsor is hard work and not an honorary title.
