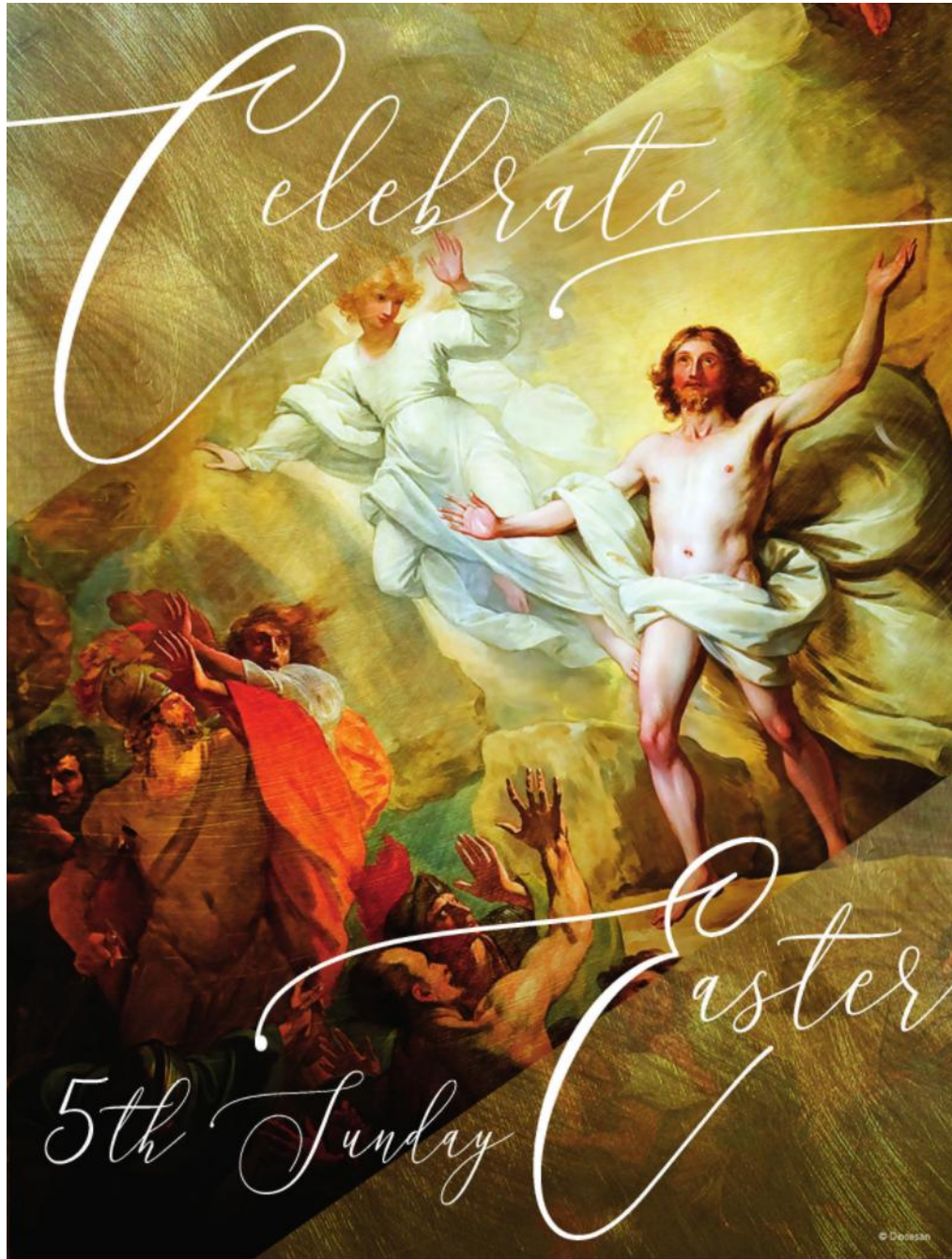

Dear Parishioners,
On this 5th Sunday of Easter, we will celebrate the first of two groups of our students receiving their First Holy Communion.



A second group will be receiving this sacrament next weekend. Congratulations to all our students and thank you to our catechists and parents who instructed them so that they would be ready to receive the gift of the Eucharist!

I promised that I would tell you a little bit more about the upcoming retreat for our active priests in the Diocese of Kalamazoo. Normally, we would have our annual retreat in Lent. However, this year, the Bishop asked that all our priests join him in a special retreat that will begin on Monday, May 15, and last until Friday, May 19. We will be at a retreat house in the Detroit area and will not be available for Masses or funerals during this time. When we come back from retreat, we will have the first of two ordinations taking place in May. The first ordination will be on May 20, and this is the ordination of our seminarian Andrew Schmidt as a transitional deacon. This will be his final step before priesthood next year. Please keep him in your prayers as well as all of our priests as they prepare for their retreat during this Synod year.

Hopefully, by this time, you have received your personal pledge cards for BAA in the mail from the Diocese. If you haven't done so already, please prayerfully consider a pledge to support our seminarians, permanent deacon candidates, and many other ministries of the Diocese of Kalamazoo. Our goal this year is \$269,893 (or rounded up=\$270,000). Please drop your completed pledge card in the mail, bring it back to Church to put it in the collection, or you may also give an online donation or pledge at the website for the Diocese. Thank you for considering a pledge to support the work of the Church.

Reflection on the Readings

Today's Gospel takes place at the last supper, immediately after Jesus tells Peter that he will deny him three times by morning on Good Friday. Jesus is trying to reassure his Disciples that everything will be well in the end, so there is no reason to worry. He says that He's going to prepare a place for them, and that He will return to take them there. Then Jesus says that they know the way, but the Disciples still don't understand even after three years with Him. Thomas questions Jesus, who responds by saying He is the way, the truth, and the life...no one comes to the Father except through Him...knowing Jesus is knowing the Father.

Still, they don't understand. Philip says to Jesus, "show us the Father and we'll be satisfied." You can sense Jesus' frustration in His answer, and can imagine Him thinking "how many times do I need to explain this...will they ever get it?" Jesus explains it again, and then tells them that if they don't believe His words then they should at least believe His works...and he predicts that they (and others) will do even greater works. And, despite the Disciples' apparent inability to grasp things even at this late hour, eventually they DO get it, as we've been reading in Acts.

We have an advantage that the Disciples didn't have at the last supper; we have the empty tomb, the words of the angels to the women on Easter morning, and the words of Jesus Himself after the resurrection. Yet, how often do we still not "get it"? Easter is not over; may we all take the time to celebrate and grasp as best we can the wonderful mystery that God has given us...may we come a step or two closer to really "getting it."
