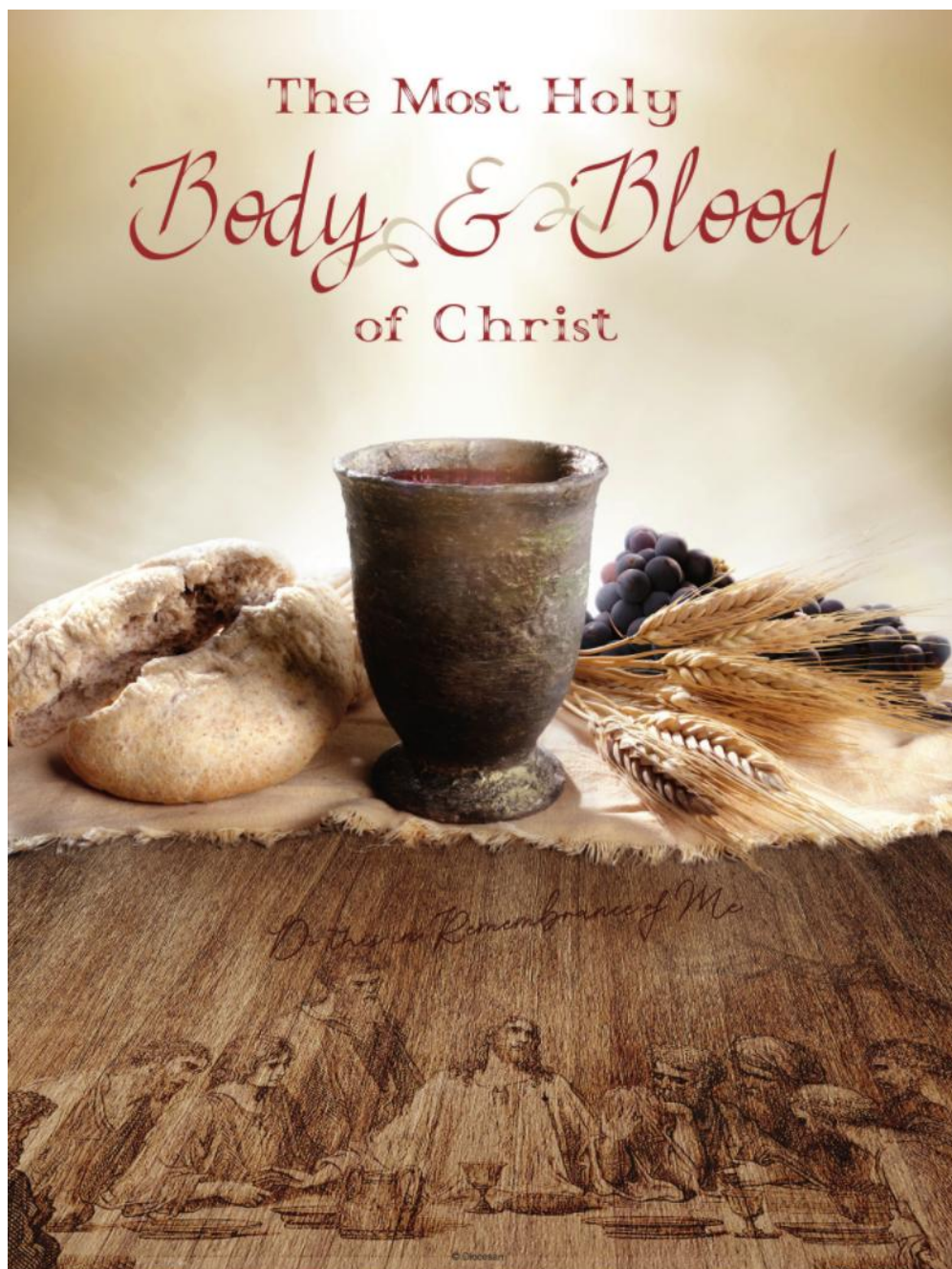

Dear Parishioners,

Over the past few weeks, I have received a few questions about the transition that is taking place with the Bishop of the Diocese of Kalamazoo. This is something that doesn't happen too often in a diocese. As we prepare to welcome Bishop Elect Lohse in July, he will be the fifth Bishop that I have served under as a priest (Bishop Donovan, our first bishop, ordained me). I would like to explain the process a bit.

The Holy Father selects and names a Bishop elect. Bishop Bradley's retirement is accepted and becomes official on the day of the public announcement. At that time, it is typical, but not always the case, that the outgoing bishop will be named the Apostolic Administrator. The administrator cares for the diocese until a new bishop is installed or ordained. During the time of the administrator, the work of the diocese is "maintained" and the status quo is kept. Any new initiatives are kept for the new bishop. There usually is a period of time until the new bishop arrives. During this time, plans are being made for the installation/ordination and bishops from neighboring dioceses are invited to join this celebration. This will be held on Tuesday, July 25, just a little over two months since the announcement. A coat of arms, and a motto will be chosen for the new bishop.

The ceremonies and liturgies for a bishop are quite ornate and filled with many customs and traditions. All priests and deacons of the diocese and representatives of the people of the diocese are invited to participate as well as the Bishop's family and friends. It is already anticipated that there will not be enough room in the Cathedral for everyone who would like to attend. Therefore, this will be a ticketed event. However, the liturgy will be livestreamed on the Diocesan website. I could go on and on about this, but I only have so much space in my column!

As the Church celebrates Corpus Christi this weekend, the Body and Blood of Christ, our priests have chosen this day to celebrate our priesthood anniversaries. After the 11:00 am Mass, please come and join us in Marian Hall for this special celebration of our 30th, 20th, and 10th anniversaries.

Reflection on the Readings

Today is the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ and all our readings relate to this most gracious gift Jesus gave us, the Holy Eucharist. Vatican II declared it to be the Source and Summit of our Christian faith. In the first reading, Moses reminds the Israelites how God sustained them in the long journey through the desert, including sending manna raining down from heaven to satisfy their hunger. This manna was a prophetic sign of what was to come...a new Bread of Life, Jesus Christ. And in John's Gospel today, we hear the Bread of Life Discourse where Jesus explains that He is this new living bread having come down from heaven. The bread He will give is His "flesh for the life of the world." He goes on even more graphically to say, "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day." He does not waiver here despite the quarreling among the Jews who hear him, "For my flesh is true food and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him." Then Jesus ends His message with words of hope: "Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever." The gift that Jesus gives is Himself. It is not the manna to sustain our physical life but the bread of life for our spiritual sustenance and eternal life. It is the ultimate gift of Jesus lovingly giving Himself to each of us in the Eucharist. Many of the followers of Jesus left after hearing this. Even today, surveys show that many Catholics do not believe in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. But as Peter summed it up so clearly when Jesus asked His disciples if they too wanted to leave, "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God." (Jn 6:68-69)

Do you believe in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist? Does your attendance and reverence at Mass reflect your belief? Do you live out your belief?
