Advent has begun! All of us who have been through Advent before are accustomed to the four candles on the Advent wreath and four weeks of Advent. But if you looked at the calendar, or read or heard some of the hints that I have given over the past few weeks, we do



not have four full weeks of Advent this year. In fact, the 4th Sunday of Advent will begin with the Vigil Mass on the 23rd and end on Sunday morning, the 24th. That means that your last candle on the Advent wreath won't get much use this year! On the afternoon of the 24th, we begin our celebration of Christmas with the Christmas Eve Masses.

With such a short season of Advent this year, the question to ask ourselves is: How will we make the most of every day of Advent? How will we prepare ourselves in a spiritual way? It would certainly be easy this year to skip over Advent and just go straight into a Christmas mode. It's certainly tempting to do this isn't it? Christmas is usually a joyous time of the year (and many of us remember Fr. Bill telling us how much he loved Christmas). I can guarantee you that Fr. Bill is counting down the days. Yet the Church gives us these days to prepare ourselves. It's a time to pray, to reflect, and appreciate what God did for us by sending His Son! We are truly missing out on helping our spiritual life grow if we just skip over all of these days of preparation.

One way that we can prepare ourselves is with the Sacrament of Penance. You may have noticed the schedule for the Kalamazoo area Penance Services in the bulletin. St Catherine will be having our Advent Penance Service this coming **Wednesday**, **December 6th at 6:30 p.m.** This will be a great way to prepare oneself for the upcoming celebration of Christmas. But if this date and time doesn't work for you, please check the schedule and see if a Penance Service on another day and time will work for you. Preparing for Christmas certainly means that we need to prepare our hearts.

In next week's column, I will be explaining how the 4th Sunday of Advent and how the Christmas Mass schedule is going to work with this particular year. Please stay tuned! Thanks for reading!

Reflection on the Readings

Today starts a new liturgical year with the first Sunday of Advent. We begin our journey toward the birth of Christ at Christmas. Mark's Gospel calls us to be active participants, remaining alert for the coming of Jesus. We can "hear" the resounding urgency as Jesus speaks to His disciples, "Be watchful! Be alert! You will not know when the time will come." And again, "What I say to you I say to all: "Watch!" But what are we to watch for? Certainly, we are watching and waiting to celebrate the joyous birth of Jesus on Christmas day. That is our first period of "watch and wait." Yet, we also await the second coming of Jesus. He will come to the whole world at the end of time when, as our Creed states, "He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end." He will also come to each one of us individually at the hour of our death when we'll be asked to make an accounting of our stewardship of God's kingdom here on earth. So, when Jesus says to stay alert and be watchful, He is not just speaking to a last generation that will see His second coming as this world ends. He is speaking about the ultimate mortality of our own lives. We don't know "when the lord of the house is coming..." Jesus gives us full warning to be alert for that day because Jesus also comes to us in the present! He awaits us in each Mass in the Eucharist. He comes to us many times each day in the opportunity to choose Him, to follow Him and to serve Him by our service to others in need. While His presence may not be obvious, we can recognize Him through "the eyes of faith" in all those we encounter. We are each called, but not forced, to respond with love to all, even the unlovable, for Jesus' sake. To summarize this Gospel passage, another word stands out: Prepare! The beginning of Advent is a perfect time to step back and examine our own lives. Will the Lord find us "sleeping" through our life and "blind" to His presence? Or will we be prepared to welcome Him into our life?






