Dear Parishioners,

Where do we see the Holy Spirit working in our lives and in the world around us? During the weeks of this Easter Season, we have definitely seen the Holy Spirit at work in the World and in the Church. As Pope Francis died right after Easter Sunday, the Church prepared itself for the election of a new Holy Father. After a period of mourning for the Holy Father, we began a special time of prayer for the Conclave of Cardinals that was to take place in Rome. The Church prayed for the Cardinals, that they would be open to the Holy Spirit working in the Church. This reflects the understanding of the early Church Fathers, who knew the importance of invoking the Spirit to lead and strengthen them as they built the Church.



Of course, we know how the Spirit guided the Church in these past weeks! An Augustinian, an American from the Chicago area would be chosen to be Leo XIV. The Holy Spirit is alive and well and continues to guide the Church as we have a Holy Father that not only has many connections to us and to our Diocese of Kalamazoo but has a missionary spirit like the early Church Fathers had. The Church always needs the guidance of the Spirit to help it to spread the Gospel of the Risen Christ. As we do for each of our Holy Fathers, keep the work of Pope Leo in your prayers!

As we celebrate Pentecost Sunday, the final day of this Easter Season, let us not forget how the Holy Spirit plays an important part in each of our lives. But the hardest part is always listening for the Spirit and how it is going to guide us in our life of faith. It's easy to let the voices of the world drown out the Holy Spirit and what God is calling us to do. Yet, sometimes, if we let ourselves be quiet, we can hear how the Spirit is seeking for us to grow in our faith.

Reflection on the Readings

Veni, Sancte Spiritus, et emitte caelitus lucis tuae radium—"Come, Holy Spirit, and send forth from heaven the radiance of your light." So opens the Golden Sequence, sung during Mass on Pentecost, inviting the Holy Spirit to come among his people again.

It is a day of rejoicing—Jesus' promise not to leave his followers as orphans (Jn. 14:18) has been fulfilled. The descent of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles also forms the conclusion to a narrative arc begun all the way back on Holy Thursday. When Jesus was arrested in Gethsemane, the disciples' trust in their Messiah was broken, and they fled. Since then, their failure in this critical moment has cast a shadow over the story, and no doubt in their own minds as well. After all, how could the men who claimed to love Jesus so much have failed him so profoundly, at the moment when it mattered the most? Surely, in the wake of such failure, Jesus would have every right to give up on them, to write them off as cowards and entrust the mission of his Church to someone more worthy.

Instead, Jesus appeared before his beloved friends, wished them peace, breathed upon them, and gave them the gift of the Holy Spirit (Jn. 20). All traces of failure and shame removed, replaced with the life-giving breath of God. Like the apostles, we too have failed to trust at some critical moment. "All of you will have your faith shaken," Jesus warned at the Last Supper (Mk. 14:27), and we have, at one point or another. Yet, despite our human weakness, God still lavishes his gift of the Spirit upon us, making us into one body and granting us unique gifts to build that body up (1 Cor. 12:7). What should be our response? To ask the Holy Spirit to remain with us always.

"The Holy Spirit has come to abide in you," St. Augustine writes, "do not make him withdraw; do not exclude him from your heart in any way...The Spirit of God is both drink and light" (Sermons 225.4).
