

Dear Parishioners,

We begin this month of November with two important celebrations in the liturgical and spiritual life of the Church: All Saints Day and All Souls Day. Even though they share some of the same elements, each one has a distinct character. All Saints Day



(Saturday November 1st) gives us inspiration in our faith life. They can help us to learn how to live our faith more fully and how to give our heart more completely to the Lord. We celebrate the saints and look to their example because they have already successfully concluded their time with us. They remind us that no matter what happens in life, that we should never lose sight of Christ. Similar in many ways, All Soul's Day (Sunday, November **2nd**) is a day of prayer and remembrance. In particular, we remember all those who have died in the past year. But it is also much more than that. We can remember all the family and friends that we have lost over the years. Almost from the very beginning of the Church, the Christian community would pray for the dead. For when we do so, we not only remember the life they lived, but we prayerfully entrust them into the hands of the Lord so that they will be with Him for all time. All Saints Day and All Souls Day are very important reminders to us how our goal is to reach and enter the gates of Heaven.

On Tuesday of this week, we will have our annual evening of Remembrance at St. Catherine. In a particular way, we gather to pray for those whom we have lost from our parish over the past year. For those who have attended this prayer service before, it is a very comforting way to remember and honor those who are dear to us. Please feel free to join us this **Tuesday at 6:30 PM.**

As we start this month of November, the St. Vincent de Paul Society continues to gather food items for distribution to those in need the weekend before Thanksgiving. If you are able to help with this, please see the display and sign-up table for volunteers in the Narthex.

Next weekend, the Military Archdiocese of the United States will have a collection to support their work. This collection is taken up once every three years. For those who are not familiar with this, these are the priests who minister to our troops both here and around the world. Since the Military Archdiocese receives no support from the US Government for this ministry, this is just one of the sources that supports our military chaplains. Envelopes will be available to support this ministry.





Reflection on the Readings

Yesterday was the celebration of All Saints, when we give praise and thanks to God for the lives of the Saints...all those who are in heaven with God (both the celebrated saints as well as those "everyday" saints) who have inspired us by their lives. Today is All Souls Day, a day of prayer for everyone who has died, especially those who are still on the way to heaven. The first reading, from Wisdom, tells us that "the souls of the just are in the hands of God", who we know is a loving God who wants the very best for us. Psalm 23 reiterates this message, assuring us that God will provide protection and comfort for His followers. In the second reading, St. Paul reminds us of the great lengths God has gone to show His love for us, and Jesus tells us in the Gospel that those who follow Him will be raised on the last day to eternal life.

Thus, all the faithful who had died are promised eternal life in heaven. However, the Church teaches that for many of us there will be a transition period...purgatory. It is not a place of punishment, for all sins have already been forgiven. Rather, God so loves us and wants us to be with Him that He has provided a way for those to have died but are not yet perfected to be made so prior to entering heaven. All Souls Day, then, is a special day set aside for us to remember and pray for all those who have gone before us (something we should be doing every day); our prayers are heard by God and can help our loved ones in their time of purification. Let us both be thankful to God for providing all of us a means to be with Him in spite of our imperfections and pray with joyful hope for the rapid transition of all who have died.
