

• Blessing/Bunnies/Brunch

- Haven't done a count yet – but we probably have over 4000 eggs. Deb will get a final count.
- Fr. Mark pulled the six names and Kristi called them yesterday. Deb will put a post Facebook saying the winners have been contacted and overall funds raised was \$636.
- Easter Egg filling party was this afternoon at 3 pm. Plan will be to sort into the age categories tomorrow at 1 pm, at which time we will count how many we have.
 - We're planning four sections of age groups: Toddlers, Pre-K, First and Second, and then 3-5.
- Deb found the plastic bags for anyone who doesn't bring a basket
- Casey is point person for Easter Egg hunt on the BBB morning.
 - We will hide Easter Eggs at 8:30 am. When we're done, there may be other tasks that need done.
 - We'll put the pools outside Stanley for empty eggs
- Al DeMars says the Knights will help with the brunch – about 4 have already committed, but he will send out another email to try and get more help.
- Plan for Stanley Centre:
 - Matt will set up tables for 200 people. We expect the 400ish people to come in shifts, or at least not eat all at once. If we need to, we can always put out more tables.
 - We will decorate as needed when he's done.
 - Tablecloths are GONE. We need to purchase more.
 - GWR will be open to Gym for kids to play in that area. We will need to get a projector and test for the movie.
 - We will have speakers placed throughout and test for music for the adults.
- Gary is going to check to see what circuits there are in Stanley and if it makes more sense to cook in Stanley instead of Marian Hall. We will still cook the sausage in Marian Hall.
- Deb and Casey will test out some music to play during the breakfast.
- Casey and Deb will work out a few extra things to do for the kids
- Deb and Casey will work on getting the giant eggs filled
- Casey will order Easter-themed tablecloths for kids to play
- Hospitality volunteers and others need to keep an eye on the trash – we have 6-7 cans available, but they could fill up fast. Maintenance won't be there for the event.

 - Syrup (not a lot)

 - We will have the table to the side with a tablecloth. Baskets will be blessed against the south wall.
