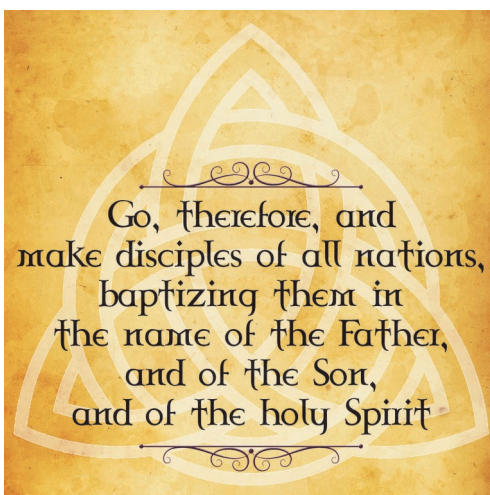
Why does God give himself a name?
