## VOLUME ISSUES FOR ST. MARTIN'S LIVE STREAMING:

Here are some general checks you can do for volume settings-

#### Option 1

For computers with separate amplified speakers (like desktops, etc.) make sure to check the volume knobs on the (typically) right speaker itself. Make sure these are set to at least 75% but usually not 100% as this can cause distortion.

#### Option 2

For laptops, desktops, etc. there are also software settings you can access via a icon that looks like a speaker, located in the lower right corner of the desktop, usually next to the date and time. Click once to popup the screen with a slide bar, then adjust to 75% or similar.

#### Option 3


When playing video from a website, etc. there will usually be another volume setting on the video itself. Normally this is somewhere on the screen in the lower left or right and uses a similar icon as the speaker for windows down by the clock.

For hardware, such as with a tablet/cell phone/etc. It is common for those to have hardware buttons located on the outside left or right to manually adjust the software controlled volume (similar to option 2)

If these suggestions do not work for you here are some other Mass viewing options:

- 1. Channel 8 on TV every Sunday has Mass from the Grand Rapids Cathedral at 10a.
- Comcast parishioners have watched EWTN channel 61 and viewed Masses several times a day and Sunday Masses.

### KEEPING IN TOUCH THROUGH COVID 19 UPDATE FROM MSGR MARTIN MAY 12, 2020

I am sending my prayers and best wishes to my parish families of St. Edward the Confessor and St. Martin of Tours ~

It is hard to believe that we are already in the fifth week of the Easter Season. This has been the most unusual Easter that anyone could imagine. For many of us these have been stressful and unsettling times. But, perhaps these times have also been the occasion of blessing. The restrictions imposed on us all have offered us a respite from the frantic pace of our normal lives. This unexpected quiet time presents us with opportunity to reflect on our lives, to discover what really matters, what is necessary, what is essential and what gives meaning to our life.

For many people this time of confinement has helped them to engage in a renewed and deeper relationship with our Lord Jesus. I hope and pray that each of us have grown deeper in our relationship with our savior during these difficult times.
