



REFLECTION ON THE FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME "I will praise your name for ever, my king and my God" - Psalm 145

God is truly king of the entire universe. Everything—past, present, and future—belongs to Him. This kingship that God has over heaven and earth is not one of dominance or one of power. Our God is a servant-king, who desires all in this life to participate and live a life of fulfillment. The fulfillment that God offers is such that even in the days and years of our life, we can experience the grace of finding satisfaction that provides us a foretaste of complete fulfillment in our eternal life in Heaven.

But what if we aren't finding fulfillment in this life? Life is downright hard, and stressful, and painful, and lonely, and difficult, just to name a few. None of these are fulfilling and tend to lead to the thought of what kind of king is God anyway? God, through His Son Jesus Christ, says in the Gospel to "come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me,...and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light." So, be encouraged and in faith, tell God of the things of your life and allow the King of kings to carry your burden with you. This act of faith, of inviting God into your life intentionally, might not yield the answer you want, but will lead you closer to fulfillment.


