REFLECTION ON THE TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

In our Gospel reading for this week, we hear Jesus give the terms of discipleship. "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it."

This denial of self and losing of one's life are some of the hallmarks that remind you and I that following Jesus and being a Christian is not an easy task and certainly not something that we can fully do on our own. But living that life of authentic charity, truly putting God and humanity ahead of my desire (to live the life of the Saints), is done when we imitate Jesus Christ by following the law of God and the precepts of the Catholic Church. And thanks be to God that our role model is not just a historical figure or a good teacher, but rather the living Son of God Who reaches out to encounter you and I in the Eucharist at Mass and is the "fire burning in my heart, imprisoned in my bones; I grow weary holding it in, I cannot endure it" (Jeremiah 20:9).
