



REFLECTION FOR THE THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT: One of the great aspects about being Catholic is that we are given both a roadmap on how to live and a great guide in how to fulfill this roadmap.

The Ten Commandments found in the 20th chapter of the book of Exodus tells us, in a nutshell, how we are to love God and love our neighbor. Adhering to these ten commands isn't just a "do this or else" list but is rather the foundation in how we find our fulfillment in this life. Are you struggling in your relationship with God? Pray over and study the first three commandments. Would you like to see your relationships with others blossom and grow? Take a look at what the Catechism of the Catholic Church says about the Commandments (paragraphs 2052-2557).

As we allow the commandments of God to take root in our hearts and let this law guide and maintain our relationship with God, we find all that we are looking for. We can echo the Psalm (chapter 19), which says, "The law of the Lord is perfect, refreshing the soul... The precepts of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart... They are more precious than gold, than a heap of purest gold; sweeter also than syrup or honey from the comb". Peace, fulfillment, happiness and holiness are found in our life with God, so with God's help permit Him to guide you along the roadmap He has before you!
