

Knights of Columbus Farmers Breakfast: Our next breakfast is Sunday February 9th after the 8:00 and 11:00 am Mass. There is no better way to celebrate Super Bowl Sunday then to begin with Mass and this breakfast! And even better, proceeds from this breakfast will support the Knights of Columbus initiative "Refund Support Vocations Program or RSVP", which "through this program, council and parish families will raise funds to support seminarians and men and women religious postulants and novices in their area. For every \$500 given to an individual, the Supreme Council will refund the council or assembly \$100. The maximum refund a council or assembly can receive is \$400 per individual supported. Though financial support is vitally important, it is not the only aspect of the RSVP. Councils are also called to provide their "adopted" seminarian, postulant or novice with moral support and prayers for their success" (from the www.kofc.org website). This year, this particular breakfast will support Deacon Paul Thuantho, a Theology IV student whose home parish is St. Joseph in Battle Creek. Deacon Paul will be ordained to the Priesthood of Jesus Christ, God willing, this summer for the Diocese of Kalamazoo. Please come out to support Deacon Paul, our seminarians and our council!

To make a report, visit ReportBishopAbuse.org or phone (800) 276-1562. When a report includes a crime, such as the sexual abuse of a minor, it will also be reported to civil authorities. Otherwise, reports will be kept confidential.

Gospel reading for this weekend finds two people, Simeon and Anna, who have been waiting. And these are not just waiting a few days or weeks; they have been waiting long years for God. This long time of waiting was certainly a test of patience, but done so with vigilance (they didn't leave the temple and kept their faith up) and intentionally (Anna was consistently praying and fasting; never giving up hope that God would answer).

How goes it with your waiting? Let's be honest, we are all waiting for something and probably multiple things. Are you patient and constant and hopeful in awaiting the answer to your questions or problems or do you find yourself impatient, doubtful, and have a basic "to heck with it!" attitude? Take some time and reread and pray with this Gospel reading. Anna and Simeon offer us a wonderful example of how to go about our relationship with God.
