

REFLECTION FOR THE SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: The readings for this weekend are challenging because they really cause us to do the right thing that we just know to do (if someone is kind to you, be kind back to them) but then extends us to the next level (if someone is unkind to you, be kind back to them). This is truly beyond what we would consider to be a normal response to things.

In order to live well this next level teaching of Jesus, we need to be like Him. We need to stay close to God and ask with faith in the Holy Spirit to give us the gift to love beyond what is comfortable. We need to truly pray for the gift to see and to listen and to understand how to best respond kindly to another whom we would view as being less than a friend.

Perhaps the best source of comfort is the words from St. Paul: "Just as we have borne the image of the earthly one, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly one" (1 Corinthians 15:49). Jesus does not leave us alone in following His teachings; this Heavenly One that is Jesus gives us the ability to be kind to those whom we find most difficult. In faith and confidence, may we sincerely ask God for this gift to be kind to all...and watch what happens!

SAFE ENVIRONMENT To comply with the policies and procedures set forth by the Roman Catholic Diocese of Kalamazoo Office of Safe Environment, the information below is run once per month in parish bulletins: The Diocese of Kalamazoo has and will continue to cooperate with the Michigan Attorney General's investigation and encourages anyone with information related to misconduct to call the reporting number set-up by the Michigan Attorney General's office at: 844.324.3374. The Catholic Bishop Abuse Reporting Service (CBAR) has been established to receive reports of sexual abuse and related misconduct by bishops and to relay those reports to proper Church authorities for investigation. To make a report, visit ReportBishopAbuse.org or phone (800) 276-1562. When a report includes a crime, such as the sexual abuse of a minor, it will also be reported to civil authorities. Otherwise, reports will be kept confidential.

Diocesan Priests Retirement Collection Sunday, March 2, 2025 During his years of priestly ministry, a diocesan priest is supported mainly by a parish community. Retirement years can be difficult for these men, many of whom dedicate as many as 50 years or more of their lives to caring for and ministering to others. Priests of the Diocese of Kalamazoo typically retire at the age of 70 and receive a pension which is used for basic needs such as food, housing and transportation. Most priests live independently during their retirement unlike priests of religious communities who live together during their senior years and are cared for by their religious institutions.
