

REFLECTION FOR THE FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT: Happy Lent! May this be a blessed season In which you grow closer & deeper in relationship with Jesus Christ & His Church.

Our readings for the First Sunday of Lent are full of so much goodness. In the Gospel, Jesus gives us an example of how to attack Lent, He Himself spending 40 days in prayer and fasting. He also shows us that when Lent gets tough with temptation to stray from our prayer and fasting how we are to stay fixed on God by staying fixed on the Lenten practices we have set-up to observe.

Remember that there are many different ways to go about Lent and to grow closer to Jesus. Here are some thoughts on prayer: Praying is essential to our relationship with God as it is a primary tool for being in conversation with our Creator. Like any relationship, being in a pattern of communication (both listening and sharing) helps us to learn about the other and gives the other a chance to learn about us. Lent thus becomes a great opportunity to further and deepen our practice of prayer by finding an additional time each day to set aside for prayer, to take up a particular prayer devotion from the Church's Tradition, or to focus in on a certain intention or intentions to hold close during Lent. These and many other ideas can help us dive into prayer.
