

REFLECTION FOR THE FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER: This weekend's readings offer some of the most hopeful words that we hear in the Bible. In the book of Revelation, our second reading gives to us that beautiful reminder that "God's dwelling is with the human race. He will dwell with them and they will be his people and God himself will always be with them as their God. He will wipe every tear from their eyes, and there shall be no more death or mourning, wailing or pain, for the old order has passed away." You see, God desires to be with His creation – God wants to be with you. Ever since our beginning in the Garden of Eden, God wants to experience life, the life that He creates, with you.

The problem is we reject God through our sin, or we only invite God into our life on Sunday at Mass but don't much think of Him throughout our week. But wants you to have so much more; He wants you to have a fulfilled life that participates in the Divine Life that He can only offer — a life of peace, joy, and happiness. We have to resist the urge to just maintain where we are at and to just be satisfied with being ok. Invite God into every moment of your life, pray and think of Him often, and allow Him to be your friend, your savior, and your rescuer. Then, you'll hear the beautiful words of God; "Behold, I make all things (read: you) new".
