

REFLECTION FOR THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

Today we are reminded of the great gift of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. There are certainly many different ways that we can think about and find Jesus but it is in His Body and Blood that we find something that is truly special, unique, and totally out of this world.

What we see on Sunday morning is a wafer-thin, circle-shaped morsel of bread that we receive in the communion line. It feels like a rough cracker and it tastes like, well, nothing much at all. And this is the closing event of our chief obligation as Catholics to attend to in Mass!

But... Think how this Jesus, our Savior, comes into the world. So dependent, so inneed, so vulnerable as a new born babe. He lives His earthly life as a simple man who meets the other with nothing more than Himself. After His death, He desires to be with you and I in a way that is accessible to all. That little cracker-thin rough piece of bread is the perfect encounter-piece for you and I to receive the heart and soul, body and blood of Jesus Christ so that He can infiltrate our lives from within you and help to make you the beautiful son/daughter that you are.
