R.C.I.A.

The Rite of Christian Initiation
for Adults

The R.C.I.A. is the process that welcomes and introduces adult inquirers (18 years of age and older), who have felt the call of God to join our Catholic Faith. The initiation process

is primarily for those who are not baptized, or baptized in another Christian tradition, or for those who may have been baptized in the Catholic tradition but have never been catechized and/or fully initiated (have not received the Eucharist and Confirmation).

The emphasis in the initiation process is on one's relationship with God, on commitment to Christ, on conversion and discipleship. Contact Karen Doyle.

Plenary Indulgence

To celebrate the 8th centennial of the world's first crib/nativity scene (1223- 2023) by St. Francis of Assisi, in Greccio, Italy, Pope Francis has approved a Plenary Indulgence.

The faithful are being offered the opportunity to receive a Plenary Indulgence, from December 8, 2023 to February 2, 2024, at our Franciscan churches where the Nativity Scenes will be available. **If you**

- * **pray before the Nativity Scene,**
- * **celebrate the sacrament of Confession,**
- * **receive Holy Communion,**
- * **pray for the intentions of the Pope,**
- * **pray the Creed and Our Father, a Plenary Indulgence will be granted.**

The Franciscan parishes in the Diocese are:
St. Andrew the Apostle; Mary Immaculate; Holy Cross; and St. Leopold Mandic (London); St. Mary (Blenheim), St. Michael (Ridgetown) and St. Paul's (Thamesville).

A plenary indulgence is a particularly powerful way to obtain remission of punishment -- on earth or in purgatory -- that would have resulted from sins that were already forgiven. It covers all sins, mortal or venial, that the recipient has committed up to that time, if the person sincerely repents, detests their sins and fulfills all requirements of the indulgence.

Church Chat.....

The Psalms give language for the many benefits of gratitude and thanksgiving:

1. **Gratitude Gives Praise to the Lord**

Enter his gates with thanksgiving, and his courts with praise. Give thanks to him, bless his name (Psalm 100:4). We know that every good thing comes from the Lord. Take time to praise and thank Him for all of your blessings.

2. **Gratitude Allows us to Appreciate Others**

I will give thanks to the Lord with my whole heart, in the company of the upright, in the congregation (Psalm 111:1). Consider the people you are grateful for. Perhaps you are grateful because of something they have done for you or for just who they are. Let them know!

3. **Gratitude Helps us See Light in the Darkness**

Make thanksgiving your sacrifice to God and pay your vows to the Most High. Call on me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify me (Psalm 50:14-15). When we are down, hopeless, or feel like we have lost our way, gratitude for the small blessings brings light to our darkness. Even in the darkest of times, remember the things you are grateful for.

This year for your "New Year's Resolution", ask God to give you a word for the year, to govern your life. Don't pick the word yourself; ask God for the word. You may be surprised by the word He gives you, but even better will be the fruits of that word if you focus on it daily. Some examples: surrender, trust, accept, grace, follow, yes, no, hope, joy, grateful, etc.....

Questions were raised among the faithful about the meaning of *Fiducia supplicans*, recently released by the Holy See.

The statement: "With respect to the Declaration *"Fiducia supplicans"* issued by the Holy See's Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith, the CCCB offered the following statement from Bishop William McGrattan, president of the CCCB.

'On 18 December 2023 the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith released the Declaration *Fiducia Supplicans*, which responds to questions that had been raised regarding the possibility of offering blessings to persons living in irregular unions, including same-sex relationships. While explicitly affirming the Church's traditional understanding of marriage, *Fiducia Supplicans* allows pastors to bless people who freely request a blessing, seeking divine help to live in fidelity to God's will. The Declaration makes clear that such blessings must be directed to the persons themselves rather than their situation and that they must be spontaneously requested and are not ritual or liturgical actions.

The guiding principle in the Declaration is the fact that the very request for a blessing represents an openness to God's mercy and can be an occasion for greater trust in God."




