The Sacred Heart Novena

is traditionally prayed during the nine days leading up to the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, which is always 19 days after Pentecost on a Friday. In 2025, the Solemnity of the Sacred

Heart of Jesus is on June 27. The Sacred Heart Novena <u>begins on June 18 and ends on June 26.</u>

Make the **Sign of the Cross**. Pray the first Sacred Heart petition: "O my Jesus, you have said: Truly I say to you, ask and you will receive, seek and you will find, knock and it will be opened to you."

Pray the Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be.

Pray the second Sacred Heart petition: "Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in you.

O my Jesus, you have said: "Truly I say to you, if you ask anything of the Father in my name, he will give it to you." Behold, in your name, I ask the Father for the grace of my request."

Pray the Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be.

Pray the third Sacred Heart petition: "Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in you. O my Jesus, you have said: "Truly I say to you, heaven and earth will pass away but my words will not pass away."

Pray the Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be.

Pray with the novena prayer to the Sacred Heart of Jesus: "O Sacred Heart of Jesus, for whom it is impossible not to have compassion on the afflicted, have pity on us miserable sinners and grant us the grace which we ask of you, through the Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart of Mary, your tender Mother and ours."

Pray the Salve Regina: Hail, Holy Queen, Mother of Mercy, our life, our sweetness and our hope. To you do we cry, poor banished children of Eve. To you do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then, most gracious advocate, your eyes of mercy toward us, and after this, our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary. In the name of Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen. (Repeat for 8 days)

History and Development of The Feast of The Most Holy Trinity

4th Century: Church Fathers, such as St. Augustine and St. Athanasius, defend the doctrine of the Trinity against heresies.

9th Century: Monastic communities begin celebrating a feast dedicated to the Holy Trinity.

1334: Pope John XXII officially establishes

Trinity Sunday as a feast for the entire

Church.

1335: Today: The solemnity is observed on the first Sunday after Pentecost, high lighting the role of the Holy Spirit in leading us deeper into the mystery of the Trinity.


