The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process in which adult men and women become part of the Catholic Church. Adults who are not yet baptized are accepted into the process as catechumens and prepare to receive the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist) at Easter each year.
