

**PRAYING THE DIVINE MERCY
CHAPLET**

Begin with the Our Father, Hail Mary,
and the Apostles Creed.

Using regular rosary beads, work
your way around the five decades
with the prayers below.

On the standalone beads, pray:
"Eternal Father, I offer you the body,
blood, soul, and divinity of your
dearly beloved Son, our Lord Jesus
Christ, in atonement for our sins and
those of the whole world."

On the decade beads, pray: "For the
sake of his sorrowful Passion, have
mercy on us and on the whole world."

At the end, pray the following three
times: "Holy God, Holy Mighty One,
Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us
and on the whole world."

It is typical to conclude the Divine
Mercy Chaplet with the words: "Jesus,
I trust in you."


