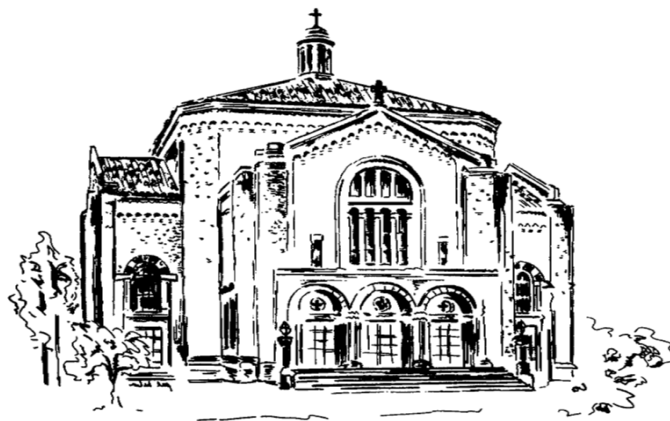

**Registered Parishioners:** Registered parishioners have submitted a form to the parish office and use parish support envelopes consistently.

**School of Religion:** CCD classes meet on Sundays k-12 for kids who are attending public schools.

**RCIA:** The Rite of Christian Initiation Classes for those adults wishing to become full members of the Catholic Church. See Ms. Diane Dooley.

**Reconciliation:** Saturdays from 3:00-3:45pm and by appointment.

**Baptism:** Parents must be registered members of Our Lady Star of the Sea Catholic Church or another Catholic Parish for at least six months. Godparents MUST be confirmed Catholics. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Prep Class prior to the baptism. Call the office for more information.

**Marriage:** The rules of the Diocese require at least a 6 month marriage preparation period prior to a wedding. Contact the church office **BEFORE** making any arrangements and to receive complete instructions. Contact the office for more information.

**Funerals:** Please contact the parish office **BEFORE** finalizing any arrangements with a funeral home.

The Family in the Catechism of the Catholic Church

### **I. THE FAMILY IN GOD'S PLAN:**

The nature of the family

2202 A man and a woman united in marriage, together with their children, form a family. This institution is prior to any recognition by public authority, which has an obligation to recognize it. It should be considered the normal reference point by which the different forms of family relationship are to be evaluated.

### **II. THE FAMILY AND SOCIETY**

2207 The family is the original cell of social life. It is the natural society in which husband and wife are called to give themselves in love and in the gift of life. Authority, stability, and a life of relationships within the family constitute the foundations for freedom, security, and fraternity within society. The family is the community in which, from childhood, one can learn moral values, begin to honor God, and make good use of freedom. Family life is an initiation into life in society.

### **II. THE DUTIES OF FAMILY MEMBERS**

The duties of children

2215 Respect for parents (filial piety) derives from gratitude toward those who, by the gift of life, their love and their work, have brought their children into the world and enabled them to grow in stature, wisdom, and grace. "With all your heart honor your father, and do not forget the birth pangs of your mother. Remember that through your parents you were born; what can you give back to them that equals their gift to you?" (Sir 7:27-28.)

The duties of parents

2222 Parents must regard their children as children of God and respect them as human persons. Showing themselves obedient to the will of the Father in heaven, they educate their children to fulfill God's law.

2223 Parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children. They bear witness to this responsibility first by creating a home where tenderness, forgiveness, respect, fidelity, and disinterested service are the rule. The home is well suited for education in the virtues. ... Parents have a grave responsibility to give good example to their children.

2225 Through the grace of the sacrament of marriage, parents receive the responsibility and privilege of evangelizing their children. Parents should initiate their children at an early age into the mysteries of the faith of which they are the "first heralds" for their children.
