#### Pastor's Corner

#### God is Good all the time! And all the time God is Good.

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Today's gospel tells us that "After Jesus was baptized,



he came up from the water and behold, the heavens were opened for him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming upon him. And a voice came from the heavens, saying, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased." These are the very words from our Heavenly Father to His only Begotten Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, at the day of his Baptism in the Jordan River.

Through Baptism, we too become children of God, we too are beloved sons and daughters of God. St Paul put it so beautifully in one of his letters, ". . . those who are led by the Spirit of God are the sons of God. For you did not receive a spirit of fear that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the spirit of sonship. And by Him we cry, 'Abba, Father." The Spirit Himself fies with our spirit that we are God's children" (Romans 8:14-16).

#### Second, Speaking Blessing over people around us!

Words are powerful. We all have the power and authority and responsibility to bless our children and other people around us every day as God the father did to his son Jesus in today's gospel, "You are my beloved son; with you I am well pleased." I do believe God the father loved his son Jesus before speaking these words, and Jesus knew that God the father loved Him, because God is love. But God the father wants to express his love through words and wants to show us the lesson on how to speak blessings over other people around us every day.



#### **Baptism:**

Parents must be registered members of Our Lady Star of the Sea Catholic Church or another Catholic Parish for at least six months. Godparents MUST be confirmed Catholics. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Prep Class prior to the baptism. Call the office for more information.

#### Marriage:

The rules of the Diocese require at least a 6-month marriage preparation period prior to a wedding. Contact the church office **BEFORE** making any arrangements and to receive complete instructions.
