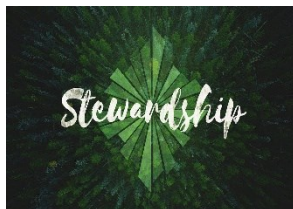
## la Sagrada Familia de Jesús, María y José *Familia de mayordomía*

## Sacramental and other Notes!

**Anointing of the Sick:** In case of serious illness, do not hesitate to call the parish office in order to receive this Sacrament.

**Adult Sacraments:** Eucharist, Confirmations, Reception into the Church, RCIA program and participation: call the parish office for more information.

**Quinceañeras:** Please call the parish office and make arrangements to meet with Father, well ahead of the date of the event (at least 9 months). A retreat and certain requirements will be required.
