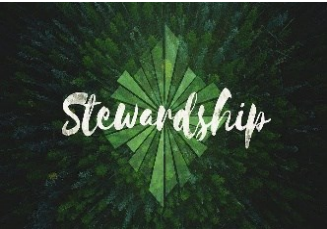
Cuatro Domingo de Cuaresma

Sacramental and other Notes!

- Anointing of the Sick:** In case of serious illness, do not hesitate to call the parish office in order to receive this Sacrament.

- Adult Sacraments:** Eucharist, Confirmations, Reception into the Church, RCIA program and participation: call the parish office for more information.
