Technology and Curriculum Committee: Update by Matt Beaton. Meeting: Matt Beaton, Joe Ficarro, Magda Harrison, Jose Villavicencio Technology: purchase of 45 new chrome books good through 2029/2030, 1:1 for grades 2-8. total inventory will get from Donna.

New projectors needs for grades1, 2, 4, and 5th: discussed mobile white boards. cost \$3-5k each for goggle mobile boards. mixed response from faculty on the mobile boards. epson installed protectors are \$1800. estimated total is \$6-8k. discussed adding technology expense to the annual budget and to five year plan. potential fund raising opportunities.

Security enhancements. There is a phone in the main office that goes directly to Shrewsbury police, Magda will contact police to in-service/train office staff on how to use it. Other ideas: intercom at the main entrance, forming a security committee. Suggested discussing with Dr. Perda and other catholic schools in Worcester district.

Curriculum: Math curriculum update is needed. Social studies last updated 4 years ago, faculty have asked for updated materials. Magda meets with teachers every 3 weeks and curriculum is one of the discussion points. Math curriculum: Magda would like the teachers to lead the review. She has asked Ellen Either and Colleen Johnson to lead the math update. Greg Sifferman is leading social studies. Aligning new curriculum with the Hartford standards. Discussed having a timeframe and deadline on selecting the new curriculum and involving both faculty and members of the board in this process.
