

Nurse's Corner

Here are a few reminders for the beginning of the school year:

- All students must have a copy of a current physical examination on file at following times;
 - Upon admission into the school (dated within the last Calendar year)
- Entering Kindergarten, 4th grade and 7th grade.

Please make sure that your child's current list of immunizations received are included with the physical.

If you have a child who is exempt from receiving immunizations, please provide the proper signed documentation.

Medications:

 If you have a child who has an allergy, asthma or any other medical condition which necessitates prescription medications on an as needed basis, please bring the specific medication in to the nurse.
This must be accompanied by a <u>prescription/order</u> from the physician.

We do stock a limited amount of over-the-counter medications in the nurse's office (ie. Tylenol, Ibuprofen, first aid ointments) which can be given. Please make sure the permission for dispensing these meds is documented in the Family Portal in RenWeb.

Lastly, please be aware that if your child is sick with a fever of 100.4 or higher, he/she cannot come to school unless they have been fever-free and have not had any fever reducing medication in past 24 hours.
