Dear Parents,

We are also concerned about the international crisis unfolding for the people of Mexico City, after several earthquakes have devastated major buildings and homes in their area. On September 25, 2017, we celebrated the Eucharist with an exceptional Family Day Liturgy and Program. Led by our SKDP Gospel Choir, the entire student body collectively stretched their vocal chords as they praised God through a medley of uplifting songs. A joyful noise filled the Drexel as every heart seemed to be burst with an exuberant spirit! Students also had an opportunity to participate in a variety of Family Day activities, which focused on family unity. We extend a hearty "thank you" to the Religion Department for a job well done!
