Despite our differences, even among family members or neighbors, we can be of one heart and mind in our faith, like the first Christian community. Each of us bears witness to Christ's resurrection, an event that transforms our lives and gives us the power to transform our world. May the Holy Spirit within us all advocate for the truth, so that, recognizing the risen Lord in each other, we may testify, like Thomas, "My Lord and my God!" (John 20:28)
