REFLECTIONS ON TODAY'S READINGS: "Feed my lambs," Jesus told Peter in last Sunday's Gospel (John 21:15). When Peter heard this he may have recalled the Gospel we hear today when Jesus described a good shepherd: "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me" (John 10:27). Sheep recognize and respond to their shepherd's voice—important in the ancient Near East when all the village's sheep were kept in a common pen at night—and good shepherds have a voice that guides and comforts their own. "Tend my sheep," Jesus later instructed Peter (21:16). Here he said, "I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish" (10:28). The disciples must have realized that he was speaking of them. Good shepherds care for their sheep so that they have healthy, happy lives, but the Good Shepherd ensures that those healthy, happy lives will never end. "Feed my sheep," Jesus commanded Peter. Perhaps he remembered Jesus saying "No one can take them out of my hand," assuring each member of the flock of his lasting protection. When Jesus commissioned Peter to be a good shepherd, Peter could think back to this day, when Jesus described that roll. How has the Good Shepherd helped you feel loved, secure and comforted?
