# SAINT FRANCIS XAVIER —FEAST DAY DECEMBER 3RD—

Saint Francis Xavier lived in the 16th century, and was one of the greatest missionary evangelists in the Church since the Apostle Paul. He was the best friend of Saint Ignatius, and they were two co-founders of the Society of Jesus. The final words Ignatius spoke to Francis Xavier as he set out on his mission were, "Go set all on fire!"


He spent the rest of his life doing just that, spreading the Gospel in India and Japan before eventually dying on his way to bring the Good News to the people of China.

Like Saint Francis Xavier, we are called to be missionaries and evangelists. We must encounter Christ and then we must share Him with others. Each of us is well-equipped with our own story to share the Good News of Jesus Christ. In the words of Saint Francis Xavier:

When trying to evangelize, no tool is more effective than personal witness. People can argue with points of doctrine, but no one can argue with a personal testimony!
