CATHOLIC SHARING APPEAL 2022

The 2022 Catholic Sharing Appeal will begin February 12th-13th.

There will be brochures and pledge cards in the pews and in the Narthex. CSA raises money for all diocesan offices, programs, offices, and ministries.

Saint Thomas More Parish is assessed annually by the diocese. Catholic Sharing The annual pledge drive goal is only half of that total, with the other half being paid by the parish

throughout the year. Our total parish assessment is approximately \$75,000, so our CSA pledge goal is about \$37,500. This amount is raised through money pledged from parishioners. Whatever is not raised of this amount is still assessed by the diocese.

Saint Thomas More has been blessed with over 250 registered households. About half pledged to CSA in 2021, and we are hopeful to increase those numbers this year. Please prayerfully consider your yearly pledge to the Catholic Sharing Appeal. Your support is appreciated by the Bishop, Pastor, your fellow parishioners, and the entire diocese!
