## ADORATION of the BLESSED SACRAMENT

### Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament

*Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament is a rite in which Jesus, in the Sacrament of His love, is not only exposed to the adoration of the faithful, but in which He, present in that Sacrament, is implored to bless the faithful present before the Altar. It is not the priest who blesses the people in this rite, it is Jesus Christ Himself, in the Blessed Sacrament, Who bestows His benediction upon them.*

### THINGS TO DO DURING EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

Eucharistic adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is exactly the same as spending time before the living God. Father Benedict Groeschel points out in "In the Presence of Our Lord: The History, Theology, and Psychology of Eucharistic Devotion" that there are 'four kinds of prayer most appropriate in the presence of the Eucharist: adoration and praise, thanksgiving, repentance, and trusting intercession.' Here are just seven of the many things you can do during private Eucharistic Adoration.

Pray the Psalms or the Liturgy of the Hours.

Meditate using Scripture.

Ask for forgiveness and intercede for others.

Pour out your heart to Christ and Adore Him.

Pray the Rosary.

Sit quietly and just "be" in the Presence of God

Read the life of a Saint and pray with him or her.
