

FAITH FORMATION FOR CHILDREN:

1st - 5th GRADE RELIGIOUS EDUCATION INCLUDING FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION PREP

Regular Religious Education class for 1st-5th graders is held in the Parish Office. Class is on scheduled Sundays during the school year from 8:50 - 9:50 AM. A schedule will be sent out after Labor Day.

Children who are 7 years old who plan to receive First Reconciliation & First Holy Communion in May 2024 are required to register. A sacramental preparation calendar will be made once registration is over.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR CHILDREN (RCIC)

Children between the ages of 6-14 who have not yet been baptized are encouraged to register for RCIC. This class meets during the 10:00 AM Mass on scheduled Sunday mornings through the school year, with reception of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist) at the Easter Vigil on Saturday, March 30, 2024. Depending on registrations, this class may split into two classes if there is a wide variation in ages of students.

ADULT FAITH FORMATION PROGRAMS:

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS (RCIA)

This program is for all adult seeking Baptism. It is also for already baptized Christians who are seeking reception into the Catholic Church. RCIA meets on scheduled Wednesday evenings at 6:00 PM during the school year, and culminates with the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist) being received at the Easter Vigil on Saturday, March 30, 2024. Classes begin in September, and more information will be coming soon!

ADULT FAITH FORMATION - BIBLE STUDIES

Michele will be facilitating Bible studies this Fall. All are welcome to come participate in these studies! Studies are approximately 90 minutes and have 10 sessions. They should be over by Thanksgiving.
