FRIDAY ADORATION

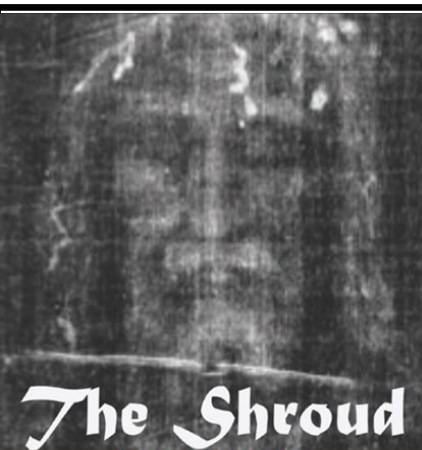
Can you spend an hour with the Lord?

It is a day of **FASTING AND ABSTINENCE!**

FASTING AND ABSTINENCE REMINDERS

FASTING

All Catholics aged 18-59 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This means one regular meal in the day, with the possibility of two smaller meals that together do not equal the size of the regular meal.

ABSTINENCE

All Catholics over 14 are required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent. If you are unable to observe the abstinence or fasting laws due to health or other reasons, you are urged to practice other forms of penance suitable to your condition.



STATIONS OF THE CROSS DURING LENT

Stations of the Cross will be immediately after the Friday Adoration ends at 12:00 PM every Friday during Lent.
